

**WCF Certificate from IIS:
Guidelines and Requirements**

Costs:

\$25 per half module, payable to IIS (a ministry of the US Center for World Mission)

Mentor:

Private arrangements must be made for payment to an accountability partner/ mentor who will meet with the student weekly for discussions of the Reflection Questions in the lessons studied that week.

Assignments:

1. Readings that do not require access to the electronic journal databases.
2. Reflection Question responses written out in the Study Guide (or typed in fill-able PDF, obtainable from the IIS office for a nominal fee)
3. Meet with an accountability partner/mentor weekly for discussion of the Reflection Questions. The mentor must submit a signed statement at the end of the half module that these meetings have covered discussion of all lessons in the half module.
4. Write the Integrative and Research Papers as described in the Study Guide. These are to be graded by the mentor but submitted for review by the IIS faculty.

Language Lessons:

Hebrew and Greek are not required
Inductive Bible Studies are not required

Suggested rate of study:

3 lessons per week. At this pace each half module will be completed in 3 months. The full program could theoretically then be completed in 2 years.

Certificate:

Upon completion of all four modules, a certificate of completion will be issued through the Institute of International Studies.
